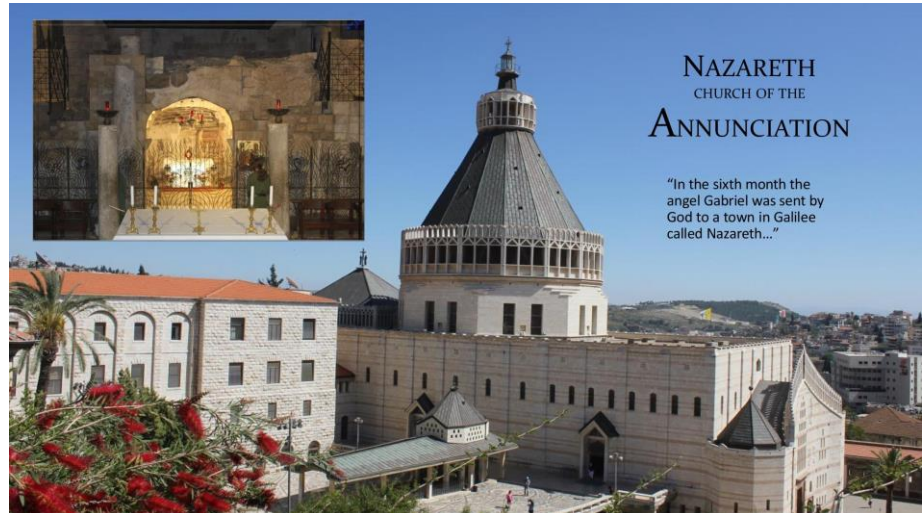

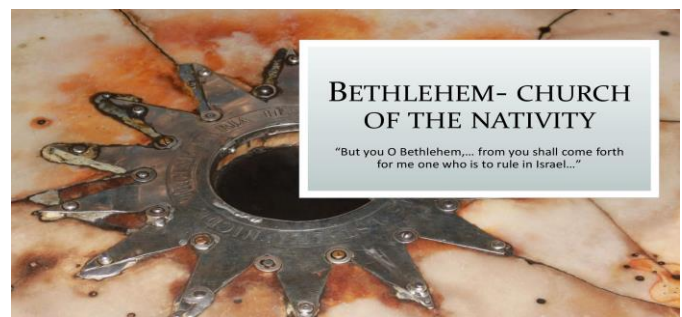

Itinerary - Father Michael Salah – September 11-22/2022

Sep 11 Sun Meet at Dulles International Airport for flight check in to TLV-Israel.

Sep 12, Mon Arrival in Tel Aviv. Meet our guide Peter and transfer to hotel in Haifa for overnight. (D) **Mass at Hotel.**

Sep 13, Tue – Nazareth - Visit the Church of Stella Maris. Drive up Mount Carmel to view the Bahai Temple and the city of Haifa. Continue to Nazareth, visit the Church of St. Gabriel (Mary's Well) and the Church Synagogue of Nazareth where Jesus supposedly read the prophecy of Isaiah. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, and the Church of St. Joseph. Continue to Tiberias for dinner and **Overnight Galilee/Pilgerhaus Guest House. (B/L/D) Mass at the Annunciation Church.**

Sep 14, Wed- Magdala, Cana, Mt. Tabor – Visit Magdala, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. Continue to Cana, the site of Jesus' first sign according to St John, for Mass and renewal of Wedding vows. After lunch, drive to Mount Tabor and meditate on the Transfiguration. **Overnight Galilee/Pilgerhaus Guest House (B/L/D) Mass at Cana together with the renewal of the wedding vows).**

Sep 15, Thu Around the Sea of Galilee Boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Then visit the sites around the Sea of Galilee associated with Jesus' ministry of teaching and healing set around the lake. The Church of Peter's Primacy, Capernaum- hometown of his Galilean ministry, then break for Lunch of St. Peter's Fish. After lunch, we will visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and the Mount of Beatitudes. **Overnight Galilee/Pilgerhaus Guest House (B/L/D) Mass at Capernaum.**

Sep 16, Fri Jericho- Dead Sea area – Jerusalem Check out. Drive to Jericho. We will visit the Jordan River to renew the baptismal vows, continue to Jericho for Mass and view of Zaccheus' Sycamore Tree, Elisha's Spring and view the Mount of Temptation. Opportunity to ride on a Camel. Stop to visit Qumran the site associated with the Dead Sea Scrolls. Continue to the Dead Sea to float in the unique mineral-laden waters. **Check in & Overnight Notre Dame. (B/L/D) Mass at Good Shepherd in Jericho.**

Sep 17, Sat Bethlehem – Visit the Shepherds' Fields. Stop for souvenir shopping in one of the Christian Cooperatives. Visit the Church of the Nativity and the Church of St Catherine and St Jerome's Chapel. Then, we will see the work of a remarkable St Vincent Creche Orphanage the only facility of its kind in the West Bank, offering Christian love to over forty abandoned babies and small children. **Overnight Notre Dame. (B/L/D) Mass at Shepherds' Fields.**

Sep 18, Sun Jacob's Well- Sebastiyya, Taybeh- Visit Jacob's well in Samaria. Continue to Sebastiyya for a short visit of the Roman ruins and Lunch. Drive to Taybeh-Ephraim (Mass & house of parables). **Overnight Notre Dame. (B/L/D). Mass in Taybeh.** (Suggested Holy Hour at 8:00 pm at the Garden of Gethsemane.)

Sep 19, Mon Jerusalem Mount Zion-Mount of Olives Visit the Cenacle (Upper Room), Dormition Abbey of Mary, and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus. After lunch, Mount of Olives Pater Noster Church, where Jesus taught 'Our Father'. Panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then walk down the slopes of the Mount of Olives, the traditional Palm Sunday route, visit Dominus Flevit, (the Lord Wept) and the Garden of Gethsemane. **Overnight Notre Dame. (B/L/D) Mass at Gethsemane Basilica.**

Sep 20, Tue Jerusalem Old City - Before breakfast, an early and prayerful walk of the "Via Dolorosa" to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, built over the place of Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Then visit the church of St Anne and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the crippled man. Continue to the Wailing Wall. Lunch Notre Dame. Free afternoon. (B/L/D) **Mass at Holy Tomb or Calvary.**

Sep 21, Wed Ein Karem – Museum- Bethany (tentative)

Visit Ein Karem Church of the Visitation and then visit the Israel Museum (Shrine of the book where the Dead Sea Scrolls) & a scale model of Jerusalem in the times of Jesus. Lunch. After lunch visit Bethany. Then **Festive dinner** at the Tent Restaurant in Bethlehem. (B/L/D) **Mass at the Visitation Church.**

Sep 22, Thu - Checkout - Mass at Emmaus Abu Ghosh (tentative)

Checkout. Visit the Shroud of Turin exhibition at Notre Dame. Continue to the Benedictine Monastery of Emmaus (Abu Ghosh) associated with the Resurrection. Visit Jaffa's Church of St. Peter. Dinner. Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for flight home. **Mass at Emmaus. (B/L/D)**

Please note this complex touring program may be subject to amendments based on flight itinerary and local daily conditions. There is extensive slow- paced walking each day on uneven terrain.
