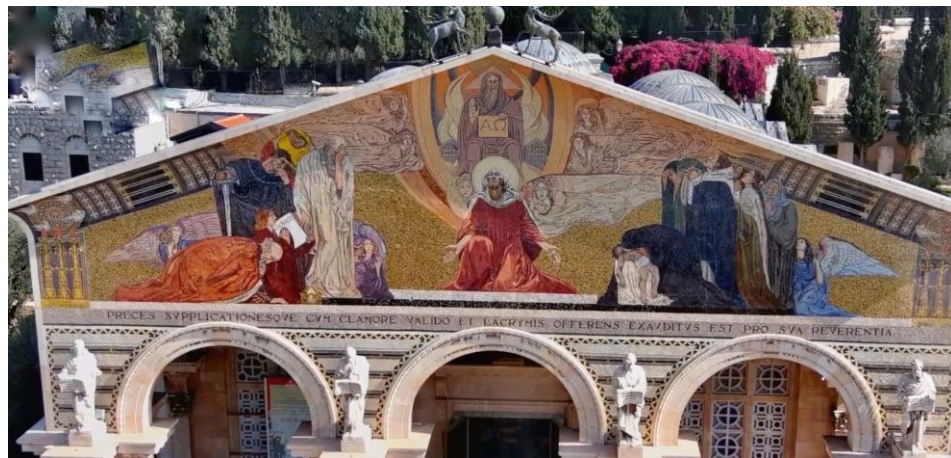

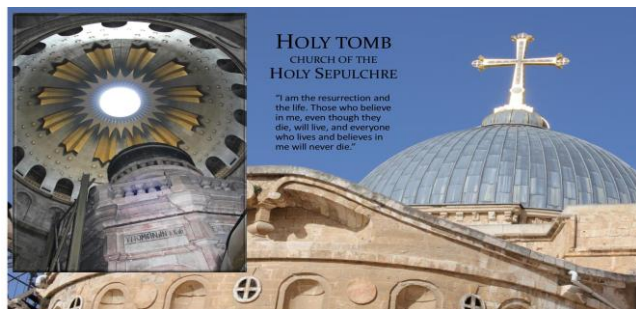

Itinerary – On the Road to Emmaus – May 22-June 1/2023

May 22, Mon - Meet at JFK International Airport, check in for flight to TLV-Israel.

May 23, Tue - Arrival in Tel Aviv on ELAL direct flight from JFK at 11:00am. Break for Lunch. Visit Caesarea Maritima, a city built by Herod the Great before our transfer to Stella Maris Guest House in **Haifa** for overnight. (L,D) **Mass at Hotel.**

May 24, Wed –Nazareth– Visit the Church of Stella Maris. Drive up Mount Carmel to view the Bahai Temple and the city of Haifa. Continue to Cana, the site of Jesus' first sign according to St John, for visit & renewal of Wedding vows. Continue to Nazareth, visit the Church of St. Gabriel (Mary's Well) and the Church Synagogue of Nazareth where tradition holds Jesus read the prophecy of Isaiah. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, and the Church of St. Joseph. Continue to Tiberias. **Mass at the Annunciation Basilica. Overnight Pilgerhaus Galilee hotel.** (B/L/D)

May 25, Thu –Around the Sea of Galilee– Boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Then visit the sites around the Sea of Galilee associated with Jesus' ministry of teaching and healing set around the lake. The Church of Peter's Primacy, Capernaum-hometown of his Galilean ministry, then break for Lunch of St. Peter's Fish. After lunch, we will visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and the Mount of Beatitudes. **Mass at Mt. Beatitudes. Overnight Pilgerhaus Galilee hotel** (B/L/D)

May 26, Fri - Check out –Jericho–Jerusalem After check out drive south to visit the Jordan River and renew the baptismal vows, continue to Jericho view of Zaccheus' Sycamore Tree, Elisha's Spring and view the Mount of Temptation. Opportunity to ride on a Camel. PM Mount of Olives Pater Noster Church, where Jesus taught 'Our Father'. Panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then walk down the slopes of the Mount of Olives, the traditional Palm Sunday route, visit Dominus Fleuit, (the Lord Wept) and the Garden of Gethsemane. **Mass at Gethsemane Basilica.** (B/L/D) **Check in & Overnight Casa Nova Bethlehem Hotel.** (B/L/D)

May 27, Sat –Jerusalem–Bethlehem Visit the Shepherds' Fields. Stop for souvenir shopping. Visit the Church of the Nativity and the Church of St Catherine and St Jerome's Chapel. Then, we will see the work of a remarkable St Vincent Creche Orphanage the only facility of its kind in the West Bank, offering Christian love to over forty abandoned babies and small children. Continue to visit the Carmelite convent and review the story of the foundress of the order St. Mariam Bawardi (Sister Mary of Jesus Crucified or the little Arab) **Mass at Shepherds' Fields at 08:00. Overnight Casa Nova Bethlehem Hotel.** (B/L/D)

May 28, Sun –Masada–Dead Sea area–Jerusalem Check out – 08:00 Mass at the Church of the Nativity. We will visit Masada the last stronghold of Jewish rebels against the Romans in 73AD. Stop to visit Qumran the site associated with the Dead Sea Scrolls. Continue to the Dead Sea to float in the unique mineral-laden waters. **Mass at Nativity Church 08:00. Check in & Overnight Jerusalem Hotel.** (B/L/D)

May 29, Mon –Jerusalem–Ein Karem - Visit the Cenacle (Upper Room), Dormition Abbey of Mary, and St. Peter in Gallicantu where Peter denied Jesus. After lunch, visit Ein Karem Church of the Visitation and the birthplace of John the Baptist. **Mass at St. Peter in Gallicantu at 11:00 Overnight Jerusalem Hotel.** (B/L/D)

May 30, Tue –Jerusalem Old City– Before breakfast, an early and prayerful walk of the "Via Dolorosa" to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, built over the place of Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection. Then visit the church of St Anne and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the crippled man. Continue to the Wailing Wall. Lunch. Guided visit at the shroud exhibition at Notre Dame. Free afternoon. **Mass at Holy Tomb. Overnight Jerusalem Hotel.** (B/L/D).

May 31, Wed –Museum Day - Visit the Israel Museum (Shrine of the book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are kept) & a scale model of Jerusalem in the times of Jesus. Visit the Holocaust Museum of Yad Vashem. **Mass at Ad Cenaculum (Cenacle Franciscan altar).** (B/L/D) **Festive dinner** (with dancers) at the Tent Restaurant in Bethlehem. **Overnight Jerusalem Hotel.** (B/L/D)

June 1, Thu –Jerusalem–Jaffa–Tel Aviv–JFK–After a leisurely morning **Checkout.** Visit the Benedictine Monastery of Emmaus (Abu Ghosh) associated with the Resurrection. Visit the sisters of St. Joseph's of the Ark of the Covenant and have lunch there. Continue drive to Jaffa to for a possible visit to the Church of St. Peter (Acts 10). After dinner, transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for direct flight ELAL at 1am on **June 2. Mass at Emmaus Abu Ghosh at 10:00.** (B/L/D)

Please note this complex touring program may be subject to amendments based on flight itinerary and local daily conditions. There is extensive slow- paced walking each day on uneven terrain.
